# WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

**university** \$      **grant** \$

(taxpayer \$, tuition \$, etc.)



**pay faculty to do research & report on results in articles**



**faculty give away articles & copyright to publishers for FREE**

(and other researchers peer review for free)





**& publishers rake in all the \$**

(and it is **BIG**)

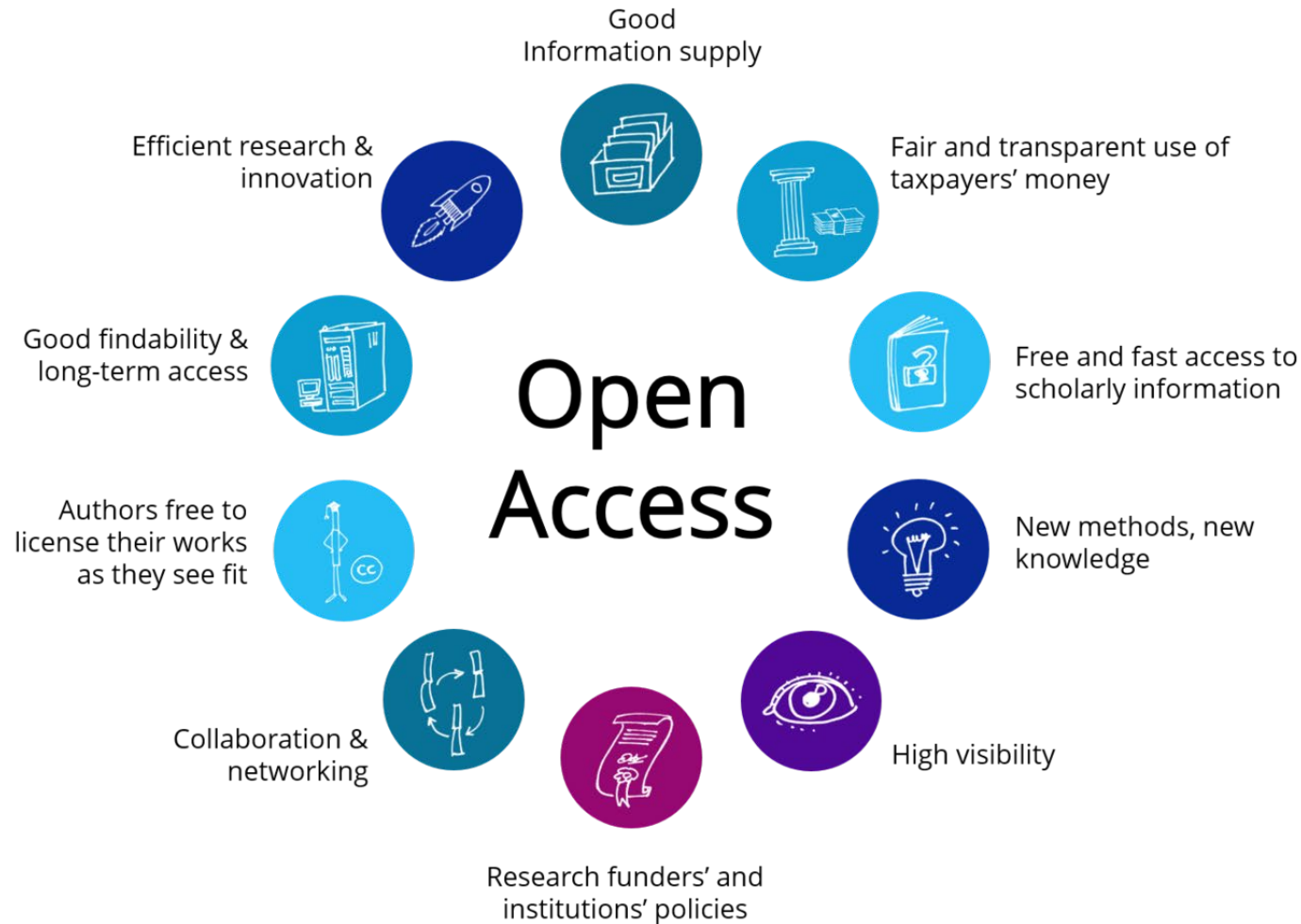

# Open Access - Benefits

## REF Open Access Policy

- Same as it has been since 2018
- *Deposit your **accepted versions** to **WRAP** within **three months of the date of acceptance** – journals and conference papers*
- We are expecting a review of the open access policy for REF 2029 which might change things

*The policy applies to journals and conference papers only.*

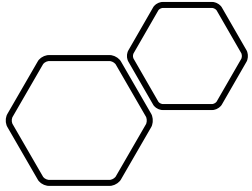


# UKRI Policy – 1 January 2024

- Original research articles and conference papers submitted on or after **1 April 2022**
- Two main routes to compliance:
  - **Gold** - final version on publisher's website
  - **Green** - accepted version in a repository
- Both routes require:
  - 0-month embargoes
  - CC-BY licence
  - Statement about the access of the underlying data for every article.

# UKRI Policy – 1 January 2024

- Long-form publications under contract on or after **1 January 2024**
- Must be:
  - Open Access within 12 months of publication
  - Version of Record or Author's Accepted Manuscript
  - Under a Creative Commons licence
- Funding is available up to specific caps set by UKRI
- Includes:
  - Books, Book chapters, edited collections
- Exemptions:
  - Trade books, creative writing, and publications arising from Training Grants.
  - Also, where the best publisher doesn't facilitate OA and/or the inclusion of third-party copyright prevents it



# SciFree Journal Finder

- Tool to allow authors to find journals included in 'Read and Publish' agreements.
- [Search for your journal](#), and if it is included in an agreement, it will appear with details of the deal.
- Journals **not** included in a deal will not appear

# Research Data Management



## What is Research Data?

- The smallest building blocks of your research
- Can be:
  - Documents, artefacts, archive material, interviews, translations, video, audio, methodologies etc.



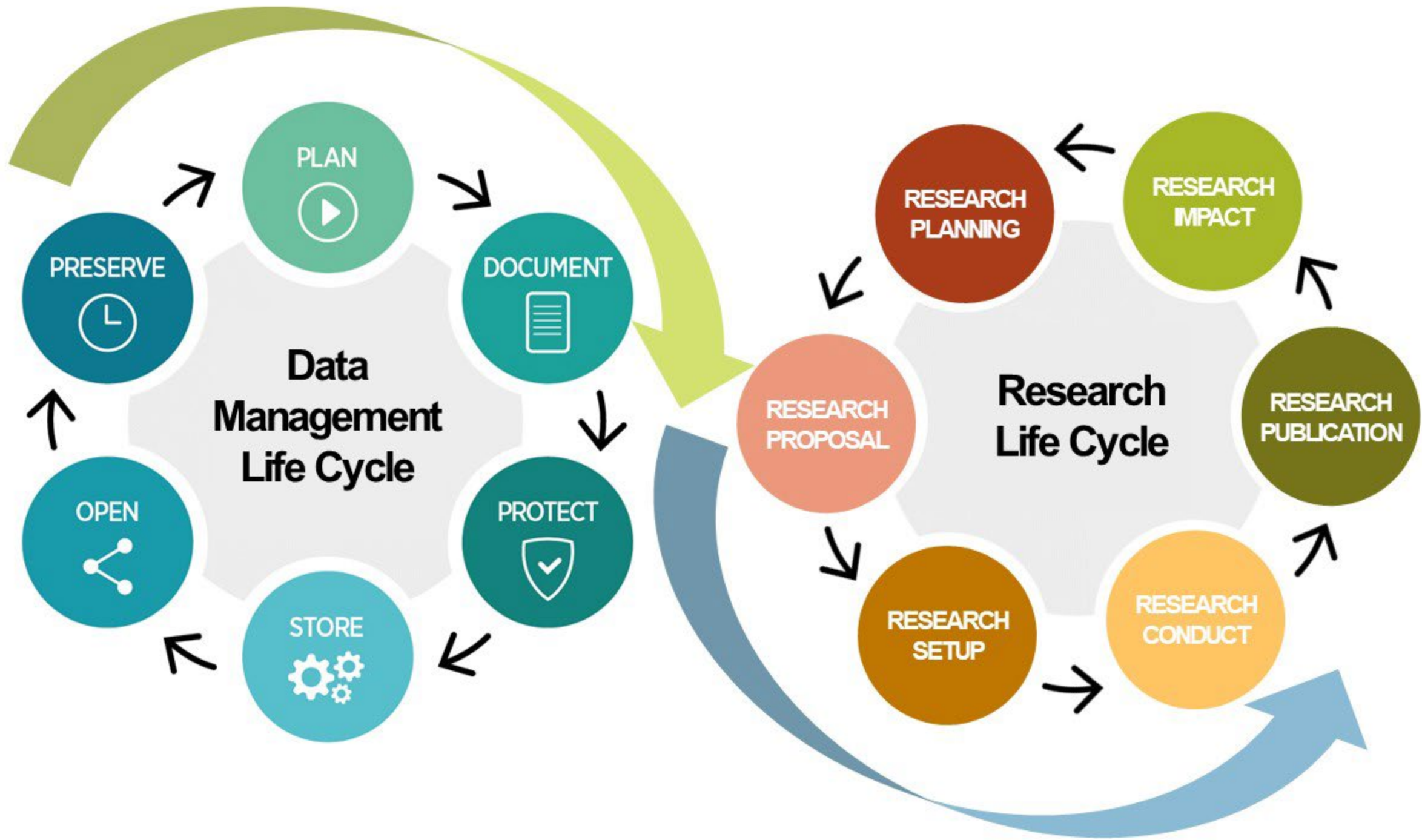
## Why Should you think about this?

- Security!!!
- Planning and writing up
- Useful for new forms of research
- Avoids duplication of effort
- Better collaborations
- Easier sharing and ability to demonstrate funder compliance



## What should you do?

- Data Management Plan (example PhD plans available)
- Audit Requirements
- Acknowledgement of data in publications

# Clearing Rights for Use

## What do you need to know?

- What are you trying to use?
- What are you using it for?
- Who owns it?
- Is it under a reuse licence?

## How to clear copyrights

- Is there a broker you can use?
- If not do you know who to contact?
- Do you have funding for rights clearance, or are you looking to negotiate a 'zero' cost solution?

- Can you be flexible in what you use?

## Top tips:

- Start early – this will always take longer than you think
- Keep all your documentation – both of any rights you cleared and of anything you tried to clear but were unable to
