# Carla Guelfenbein

Carla Guelfenbein is a Chilean novelist and screenwriter.

Exiled in England after the 1973 coup, she studied at Essex University and St. Martin's School of Art in London. She has worked as art director and editor of the fashion magazine *Elle*, and is a critically acclaimed novelist who has been translated into most major European languages. Her most recent novels are *El resto es silencio* (translated as *The Rest is Silence*), and *Nadar desnudas*. During her visit to Warwick as Santander Writer-in-Residence in Hispanic Studies, Carla Guelfenbein will read from her work and discuss themes of exile and silence in literature.
