You might like to use troubadour songs as a basis for inspiration (see the website), but there is no requirement to link the poem to the medieval context: you may treat the subject as you choose.

Prizes of £50, £30 and £20 will be awarded to the three best entries in each of two categories: up to and including age 15, and 16 and over. The competition will be judged by the poet Grevel Lindop, and the best entries will be posted on the website.

Anyone may take part, and participation by schoolchildren is particularly encouraged; £50 will be given to the school of a main prize-winner in full-time education.
