We have received a letter from Collet's Holdings Ltd. in London. First, they would like to become the distributor for Robeson records in the British Commonwealth and possible in Wastern Europe. Secondly, they say that in view of the embargo placed by the British Government on the transfer of dollars to pay royalties resulting from the sale of Prul Robeson records, they would like to exchange with us masters of folk music which are available to them. Our difficulty is that we do not as yet have sither the large distribution system, or the production facilities to press and of tribute large numbers of a variety of records simultaneously. Therefore, as this stage it is necessary for as he make some arrangements shereby our master can be sold for sollars and shareby royalties (at least some fortion of them) can be transferred in tollars.

I would appreciate it very much if you could look into this matter futuel and give us some idea of the possibilities.
