**Exchanges** is a peer-reviewed, open access, scholar-led, international, interdisciplinary research journal, which champions publications from early career researchers.

The title is published by the **Institute of Advanced Study (IAS)**, **University of Warwick**, UK, in association with their Global Research Partners\*.

*Exchanges* has a rich heritage of fostering new voices and emerging domain experts within all academic disciplines.

We invite high-quality submissions from researchers working in all academic fields, especially from first-time and early career authors or all scholars developing with interdisciplinary research.

**Conversations:** Dialogues with significant research figures, focusing on interdisciplinary contributions (3,000-5,000 words).

**Research articles:** Outcomes, application or impact of original, unpublished research (4,000-6,000 words).

**Review articles:** Summaries concerning the current state of understanding on topics, highlighting key papers and authors (3,000-5,000 words).

**Critical Reflections:** Focussed appraisals concerning emerging research areas, key events or crucial new texts (1,000-3,000 words).

Submissions for future issues are always welcome, alongside regular 'themed submissions' calls. New issues, published biannually, contain a range of article formats.



An international **Editorial Board** comprised of early career researchers, drawn from all disciplinary areas, manages *Exchanges*.
