routes to and benefits of OA publishing and gave details of support at Warwick for Open Access. 'Best effort' to provide Open Access was required in

7 pilot areas under FP7. Under Horizon 2020 there is an obligation to provide Open Access to peer reviewed publications in all areas (during the project).

Publishing costs are eligible-costs for projects whilst projects are running. (*the presentation* 2).
