- Contact numbers and email address(es)
- Whether you wish it to be a paper or a poster presentation

The abstract should be no more than 250 words in length (excluding the above information).

Abstracts will be selected and approved by the conference committee. Accepted papers and posters will be notified by 23rd May 2008.

Single papers will be allocated 20 minutes for presentation, including 10 minutes for questions and discussion, and posters will be on display all day.
