Call for papers

We invite postgraduate students to submit an abstract for either a paper or a poster presentation linked to one of the following four themes:

- Language Learning and Pedagogy
- Working and Communicating Across Cultures
- Professional and Academic Discourse
- Teacher Education and Development

Presentations on other topics are also welcome.

Abstracts are for either paper or poster presentations. The deadline for receipt of abstract is the 10th of May 2010. Abstracts must be submitted electronically as a Microsoft Word document using the online abstract submission page at <http://www2.warwick.ac.uk/fac/soc/al/research/conferences/wpgc2010/cfp/submission>.

Your abstract must include the following information:

- The title
- Name and affiliation of the author(s)

The abstract should be no more than 250 words in length (excluding the above information).

Abstracts will be selected and approved by the conference committee. Accepted papers and posters will be notified by 17th of May 2010.

Single papers will be allocated 30 minutes for presentation, including 10 minutes for questions and discussion, and posters will be on display all day.

Pre-conference workshops (Tuesday, 22nd June at Social Sciences Building, Room A0.23)

A range of pre-conference workshops are offered to participants on the day before the conference, Tuesday 22nd June. The workshops will be up to 1.5 hours long and are run by members of the Centre for Applied Linguistics.
