Papers (and reviewer comments) are distributed to the group prior to the meeting so that ALL participants can scrutinize the manuscripts and come to the sessions with very detailed ideas on how the scholars might improve their manuscripts. The sessions provide a vibrant intellectual discussion for all concerned and are followed by an evening dinner.
