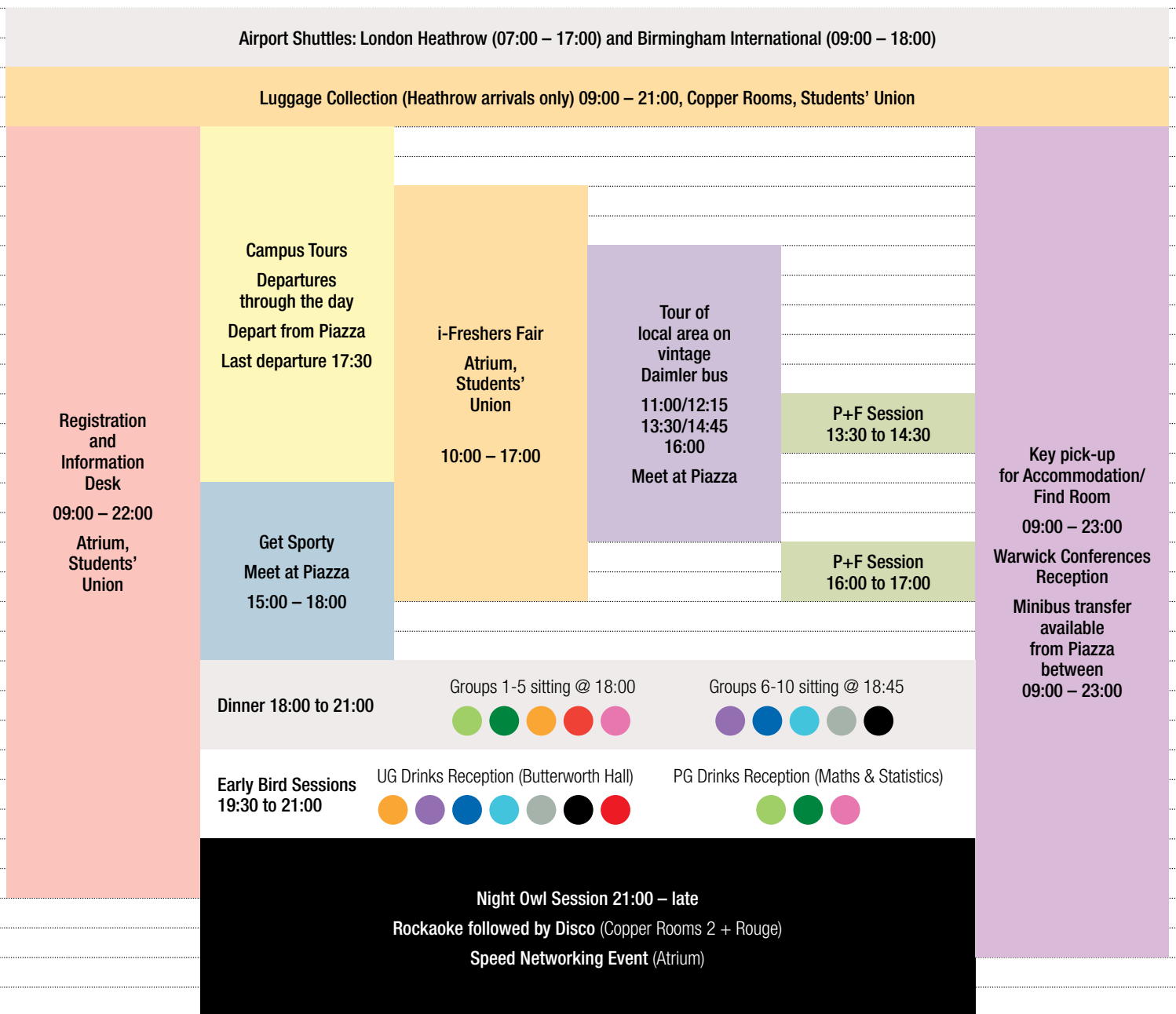
Night Owl Event: Rockaoke and Speed Networking

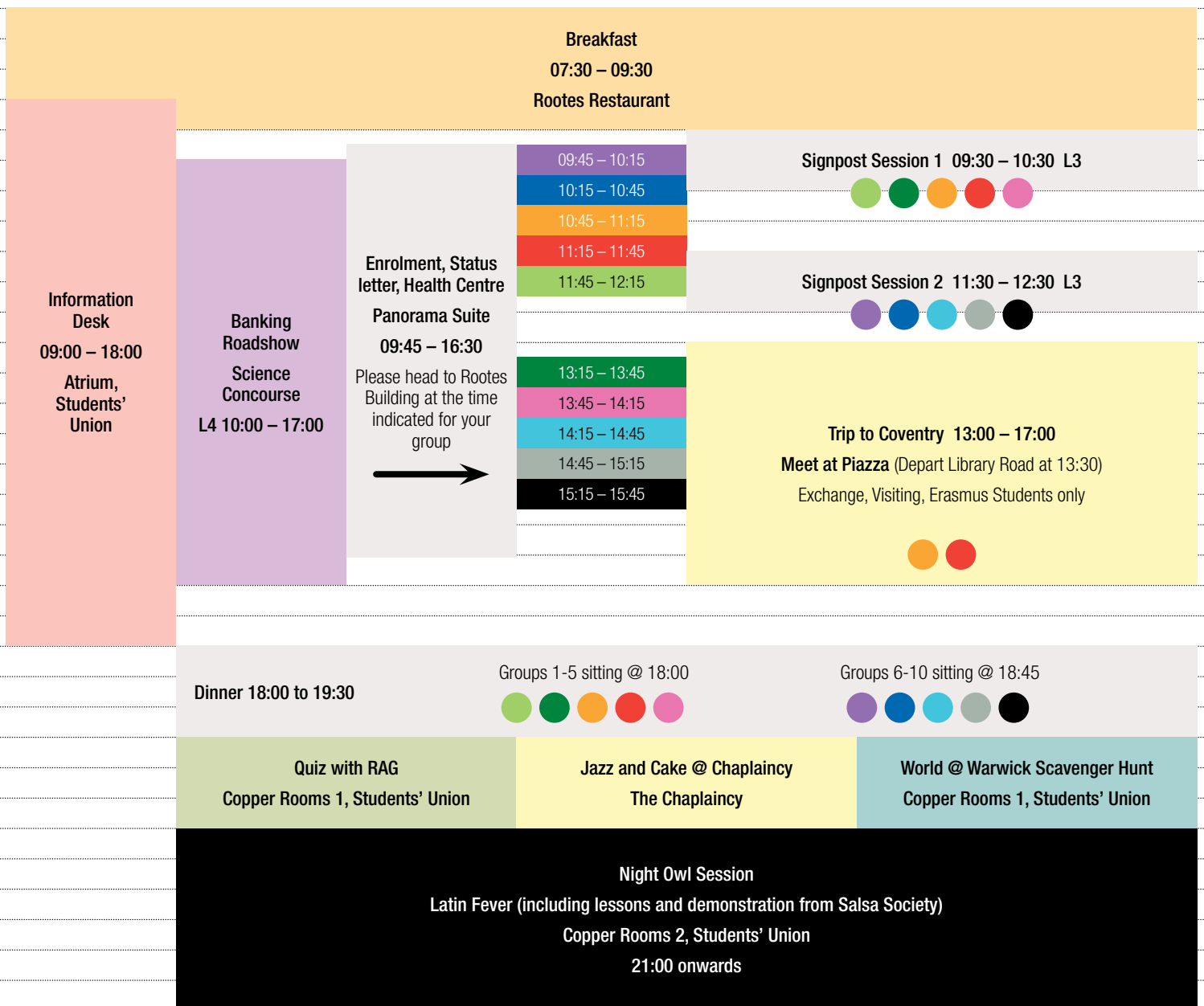

University Enrolment/Status Letters/Health Centre registration

Location: **Panorama Room, Rootes Building**

Enrolment: Complete enrolment by collecting your student ID card and arrange to pay your fees. All students should bring their passports containing their UK visa (or Biometric Residence Permit if applicable) with them to this event. You must also bring your Certificate of Online Enrolment with you.

Student Status Letter: You will obtain your Student Status Letter in order to open a bank account or set up a mobile phone contract.

Health Centre: It is very important for all students to register with a doctor as soon as they arrive in the UK.

You will need to bring your completed registration form, your full residential address and Student ID number with you, as well as your NHS number if you have previously been registered with a doctor in the UK

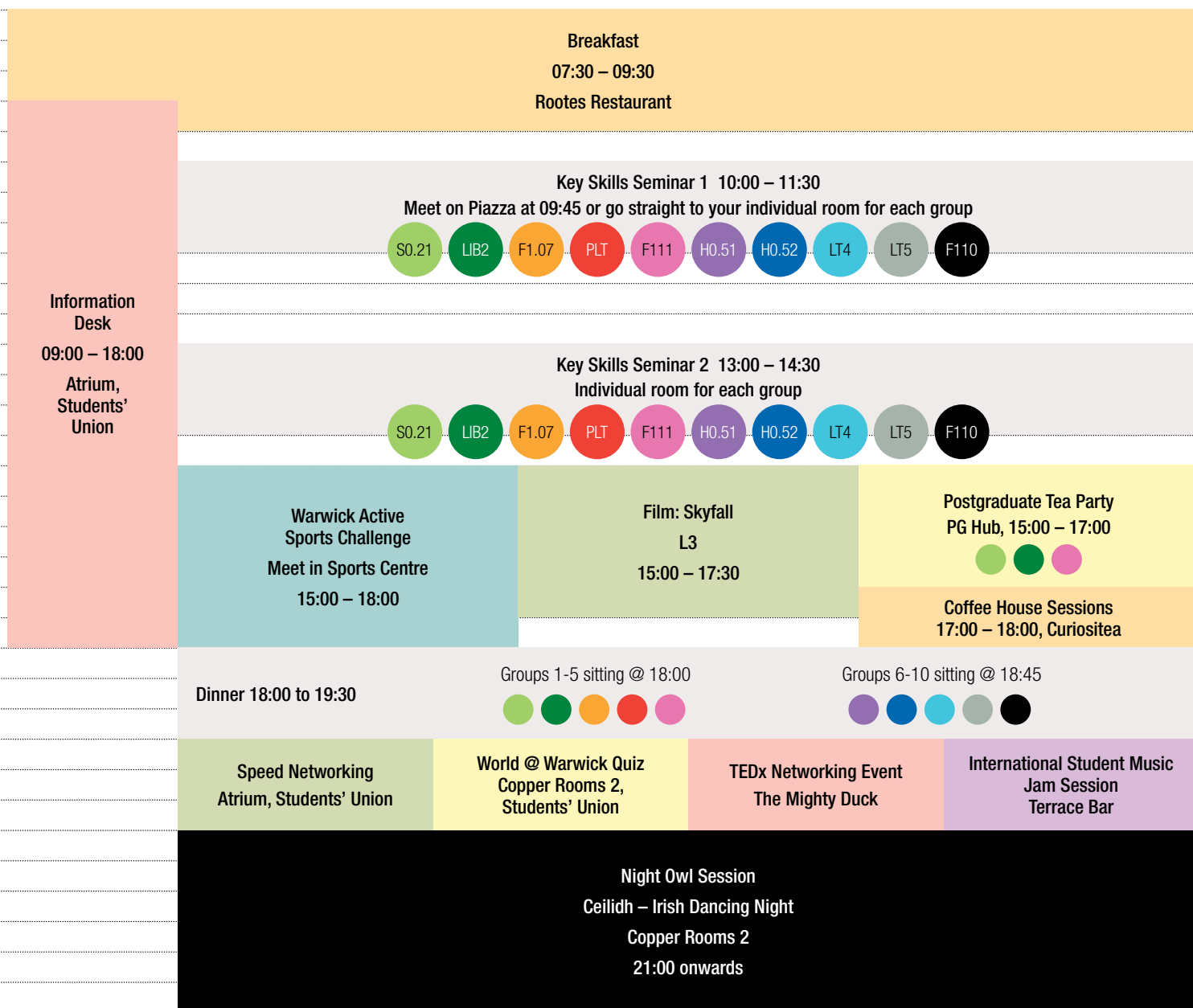

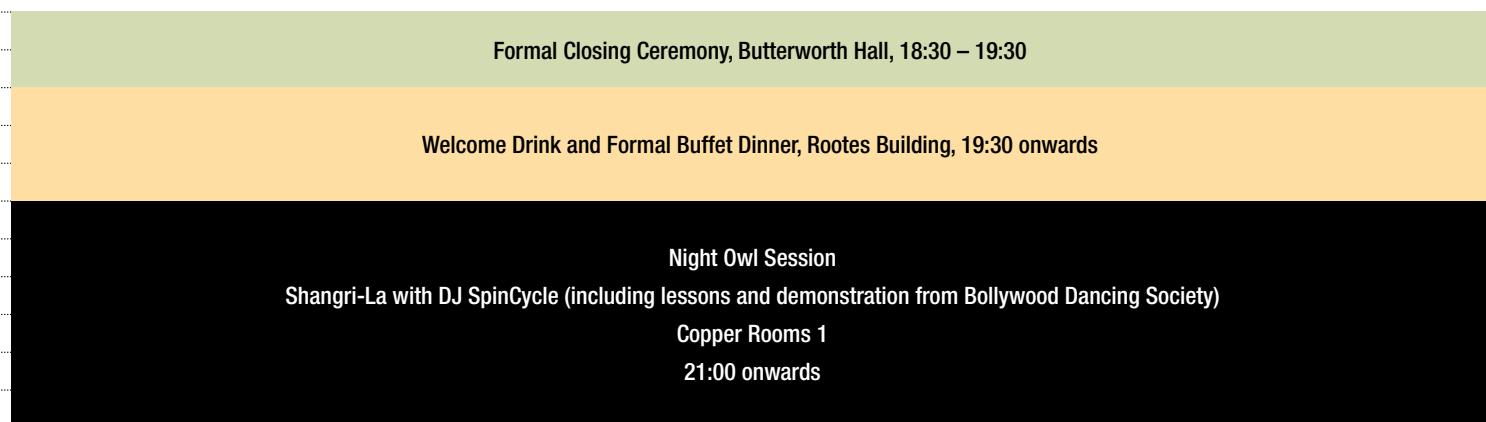
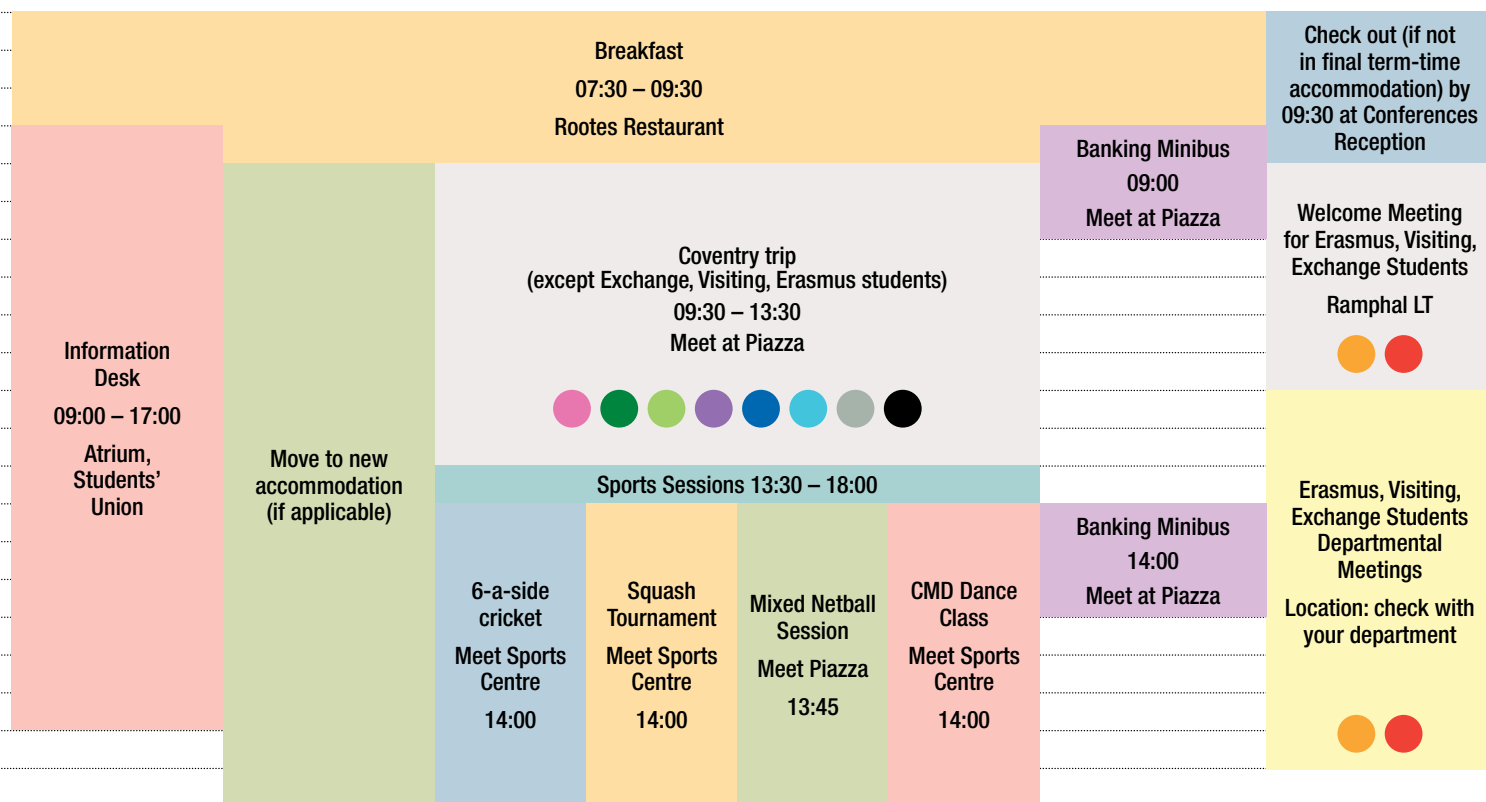

Programme information

Arrival at Warwick

Register

On arrival you need to register for Orientation 2013 at the Registration Desk in the Atrium of the Students' Union.

Orientation wristband

At the registration desk you will be given your Orientation wristband and an Orientation bag containing the programme and further information.

Luggage

If you have travelled to Warwick using the airport coach pick-up service from London Heathrow, your luggage will arrive separately at the University in one of several luggage vans. It will be unloaded and stored securely in Copper Room 1 at Warwick Students' Union. Announcements will be made informing you when you can collect your luggage throughout the day.

Collect your keys

You will be able to collect your key from Warwick Conferences Reception between 07:00 and 23:00. If we are aware that you will be arriving after this time then your key will be sent to the Security Gatehouse and you will be able to collect it from there. Minibuses will be providing a shuttle around campus to take students to their accommodation in the furthest areas from central campus between 09:00 and 21:00. These minibuses will leave from the Piazza.

Settle in and take part!

Once you have found your room, dropped off your luggage and registered, follow the programme and enjoy your first few hours on campus; try and join a campus tour, take a look at the i-Freshers Roadshow and take in a tour of the local area on a vintage Daimler bus. Don't forget to go to dinner and then join a drinks reception at 19:30 in order to meet other students.

Orientation 2013 Wristbands

You should wear your Orientation wristband throughout Orientation. Do not lose it! You will need this to access the evening events throughout the week otherwise you may be charged.

In your Orientation timetable, you will see that you have been allocated specific events according to your wristband colour. Please do not swap wristbands with other attendees as the events allocated to their colour may not be suitable for your study level or enrolment time slot.

Students' Union

Warwick Students' Union is an independent, representative organisation run by seven elected Sabbatical Officers or 'Sabbs' who work full time to make sure that you get the best out of your experience at Warwick. Warwick SU facilitates all student-led societies, sports clubs and outlets within the two buildings (including Xananas, Curiosity, Dirty Duck, Terrace Bar, Bread Oven and Copper Rooms) and is democratically run by students for students. Warwick SU works to represent your views to the University on issues concerning to students, and seeks to campaign for change and improvement where students identify the need. All turkey, chicken, and lamb in their outlets is Halal.

Eating on Campus

Breakfast and dinner are provided as part of the Orientation programme. However for lunch and snacks you can visit one of the many shops and cafés on campus. There are plenty of places to eat which provide a wide variety of food including vegetarian options. Warwick Retail provides food and drink at a large number of venues all around campus and Warwick SU offers a further choice of reasonably priced food and drink in its venues. Costcutter is the main supermarket on campus and there you will find a range of food, drink and household goods.

Information Desk

There will be an Information Desk available throughout Orientation in the Atrium of Warwick Students' Union. This is where you should report in the case of an emergency or come to enquire about lost property. The opening times of the Information Desk are shown on the day planner for each day. In case of emergency out of hours please refer to the back page of the Orientation programme for useful contact details.

Swimming Pool

Attendees will have free access to the swimming pool in the Sports Centre during Orientation, as follows:

Tuesday – 14:30-16:00
Thursday – 16:00-18:00
Friday – 16:00-18:00

Simply present your Orientation wristband at the entrance to allow entry.

Faith Provision

The UK is a country where everyone has a legal right to practise his/her religion. It is a multi-faith society with a great richness of faith traditions and cultures.

On the Warwick campus there are very good relationships between major faith communities. The University Chaplaincy (the space on central campus dedicated to faith) is open to all faiths and is often used as a social meeting place for international students (especially in University vacations).

The University has a Jewish, Muslim, Methodist, Catholic and Anglican chaplain. Next to the Chaplaincy, there is an Islamic Prayer Room situated next to Senate House. It offers facilities for daily prayers and regular meetings.



Certificate of Student Status/ Student Status Letter

You will need a Certificate of Student Status to open a bank account or register for a mobile phone contract. It is essential to obtain this from the Status Letter Collection Point at the Enrolment event on Wednesday 25th September. Please ensure you attend the correct time slot for your colour of wristband (see programme).

Opening a Bank Account

There will be an opportunity to open a bank account during Orientation. Staff from a selection of banks will be available in the Science Concourse on Wednesday 25th September. They will provide you with information about the accounts they have available and you will be able to start the process of opening an account.

Lloyds TSB will be at the Banking Roadshow on Wednesday, but if you want to see them in branch, or missed them at the roadshow, we will have minibus running on Friday 27th at either 09:00 or 14:00 which will take you there and bring you back to campus. Please do not forget your passport or Student Status letter, as well as any bank drafts you would like to pay to your new account.

Places are limited, so please sign up in advance at the Information Desk.

Police Registration

You may have a requirement to register with the police marked on your visa. There is updated information about police registration at www.warwick.ac.uk/policeregistration. Don't worry that you are not able to see the police within seven days of arriving in the UK as long as you follow the instructions on this website.

'Key Skills' Sessions

The Centre for Applied Linguistics is pleased to provide a range of sessions during Orientation, which we hope you will find useful. The aim of the sessions is to give you an introduction to academic life in the UK as well to help you better understand the role cultural differences can play in adjusting to your new life in Warwick. As a participant in the programme, you will be expected to attend both sessions- this is a great way to settle into UK academic life, quicker!

Academic and Language Skills

This session considers the main academic and linguistic requirements for studying successfully within a UK university. It includes a focus on the following areas: making sense of/evaluating sources of information, and avoiding plagiarism; planning and writing an assignment; increasing participation in seminars; making appropriate use of the library, self-directed learning and time; appropriate use of formal and informal language.

Cultural Awareness and Inter-cultural Skills

This session is designed to develop familiarity with British culture, and to consider the skills needed to work with students from different cultures and backgrounds. Among the topics considered in this session are the following: culture shock, stereotyping; inter-cultural competence (including information gathering, flexible thinking and improving self-awareness).

'Signposts' Sessions

This session is a practical guide to life on campus and will feature speakers from services including Careers & Skills, the Immigration Service, the Library, and Warwick Sports. The Signposts session will give you all the key messages about how to access these services so that you know who to ask if you need help and that you feel able to make the most of all the opportunities available.



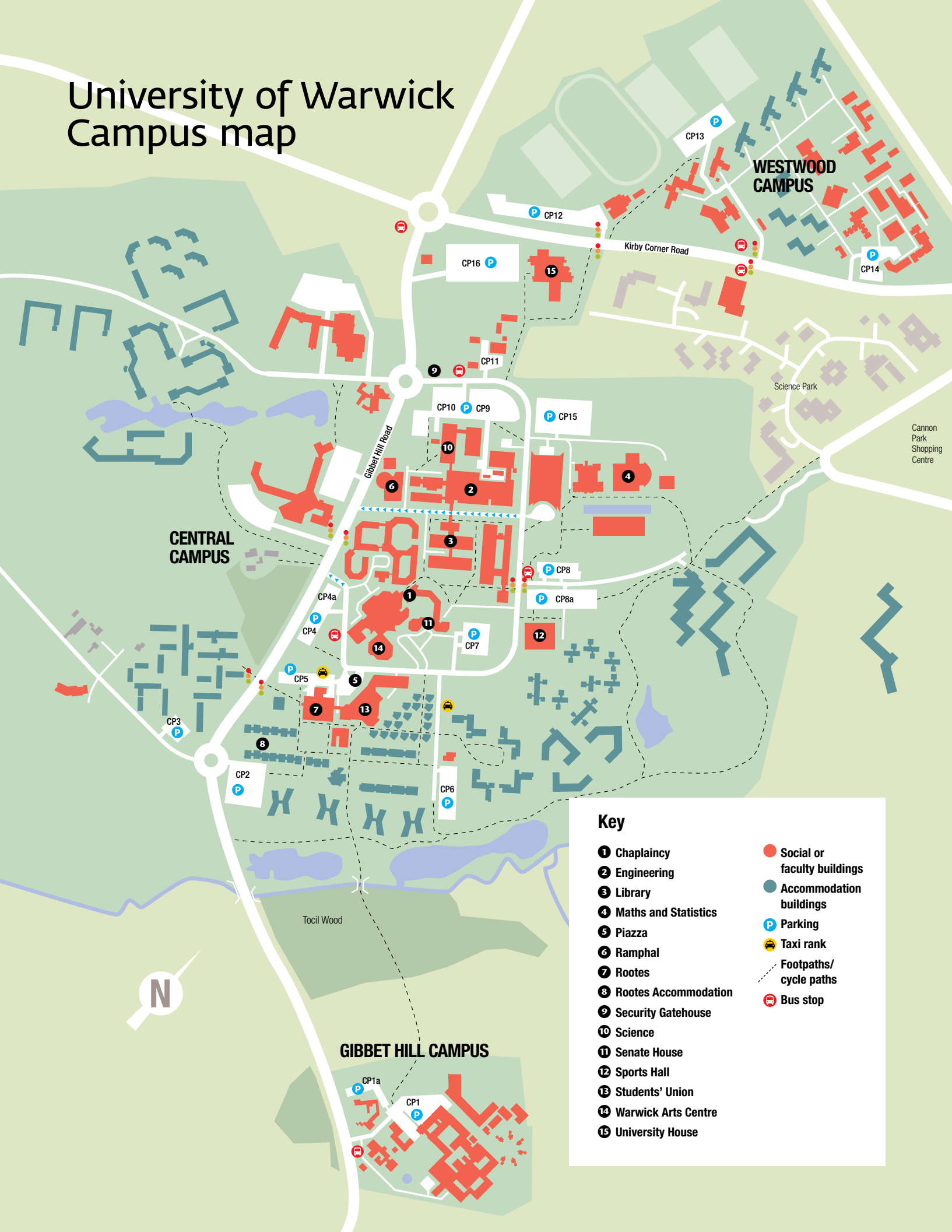
Coventry City Centre
