### 524/08-09 Proposed Additional HR Policies

### CONSIDERED:

A paper from the Director of HR outlining the key principles of three proposed additional HR policies written to support Heads of Department in managing the current financial situation (SC.429/08-09).

REPORTED: (by the Director of HR and Commercial Services)

- (a) That given the need to implement the policies this term, the Treasurer had approved the financial principles underpinning the policies by Chair's Action on behalf of the Finance and General Purposes Committee and the Chair of Council had approved the policies by Chair's Action on behalf of the Council.
- (b) That the proposed new policies would be discussed with Heads of Department at the forthcoming Away Day, and that optional workshops would also be offered to Heads of Department to further explain the policies.
- (c) That the University reserved the right to decline to accept applications from staff under these schemes.
- (d) That communication of the policies to the wider University community, particularly the Enhanced Leavers Scheme, would need to be handled carefully.

#### **RESOLVED:**

- (a) That the proposed additional HR policies be approved as set out in SC.429/08-09, subject to the inclusion of the clarifications discussed at the meeting.
- (b) That the Director of HR and Commercial Services work with the Director of Development, Communications and Strategy to draft a carefully-worded communication to publicise the new policies after the Heads of Department Away Day.

### 525/08-09 Academic Continuity Planning

#### CONSIDERED:

A paper from the Academic Registrar outlining the proposed contingency plans to be put in place to mitigate the impact of any potential industrial action (SC.435/08-09).

REPORTED: (by the Academic Registrar)
