As you have been invited to attend a selection day here at the University of Warwick, please read the following carefully.

### **Outline of Selection Day**

The selection process will consist of a half-hour written test and a small group exercise. Then you will be interviewed by one of our teaching staff and a social work practitioner.

The written test is used primarily to test your writing skills and the group activity is used to examine how your work with a group and communicate verbally. Whilst taking into account your understanding of social work, in-depth knowledge is not required. The interview process is informed by the Professional Capabilities Framework of the British Association of Social Workers (<https://www.basw.co.uk/pcf/>) - you may wish to consult this in advance of the interview.

In total the process will last for approximately two and a half to three hours.
